

**Avant STAMP** tests are web-based and report scores at benchmarks characterizing proficiency levels similar to the ACTFL Performance Guidelines.

**STAMP tests:**

- engage students in real world scenarios and encourage them to show what they can do with language
- provide educators with access to data to check progress and review programs
- empower informed decisions around staff development and instructional planning

**STAMP reports:**

- scores for individual students and groups
- are exportable to Excel for flexible analysis
- are available immediately for listening/reading and in three business days for writing/speaking

**STAMP tests:**

- are realia-based, textbook-independent and computer adaptive
- allow teacher-playback of all student oral-responses and the ability to review written responses
- are statistically validated and externally rated with inter-rater reliability

**STAMP 4S** is the 4-skill proficiency test for students in middle school through university.

**STAMP 4Se** is the 4-skill proficiency test for students in grades 3 through 6.
